Resolution #2019-02: A Resolution of the Petersburg Borough Assembly Supporting Proposed Amendments to the Population Caps Within the Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) Formula

Mayor Jensen requested this resolution. The National Association of Counties (NACo) found that the current Payment in Lieu of Taxes formula used by the federal government does not fairly disperse PILT revenue to counties and boroughs with populations under 5,000 compared to counties and boroughs with populations above 5,000. NACo recently passed a resolution requesting an amendment to the population caps within the formula and have asked for support from the counties and boroughs affected.

Member Stanton Gregor is interested in assigning designated Assembly seats for

	election purposes. If the idea is adopted by the Assembly, the Borough would have one Mayor's Seat and 6 Assembly Seats (Assembly Seat #1, Assembly Seat #2, Assembly Seat #3, Assembly Seat #4, Assembly Seat #5 and Assembly Seat #6). Rather than the ballot showing (as an example) two Assembly seats up for election with five candidates running - but stating, "vote for no more than two", there would instead be (as an example) Assembly Seat #2 with those candidates that chose to run for that specific seat and a statement to "vote for no more than one", and Assembly Seat #5 with those candidates that chose to run for that specific seat and a statement to "vote for no more than one", etc.
	Clerk Thompson contacted 10 communities (Craig, Haines, Homer, City of Ketchikan, Ketchikan Gateway Borough, Seward, Sitka, Skagway, Wrangell and Yakutat) and learned that none of them have designated Assembly seats for election purposes. They elect their Assembly members in the same manner as Petersburg does currently.
	Member Stanton Gregor is inquiring if there is interest on the Assembly to request Clerk Thompson draft an ordinance to assign designated Assembly seats for election purposes.
