
Reduce your out-of-pocket costs

As a valued Moda Health member in Alaska, your travel benefits cover transportation services for special elective surgeries, an unexpected illness, injury or life-threatening medical conditions. With Moda, you get the treatment and care when it matters most.



If you're planning an elective surgery, your Moda benefits cover **100%** of your travel expenses to see a qualified provider that's right for your surgical needs. Through our partner, **Transcarent Surgery Care**, a dedicated care coordinator will manage everything from approvals and paperwork to recovery and travel arrangements. All you have to do is show up for the surgery and focus on healing.

Your travel benefits cover transportation services to and from your surgery location for the following non-emergency surgeries:

Additional plan coverage for emergencies and other health conditions

Your Moda Health plan also covers transportation services for other non-emergency and life-threatening medical conditions or injuries, including:

+ Ambulance transportation

If you require emergency services that are not available at a local facility, licensed ground, water and air ambulance transportation and other services are covered on the way to the nearest facility that can provide you with the care you need. This includes non-emergency air ambulance transports from one facility to another. Prior authorization for non-emergency trips is required.

Commercial transportation

When a sudden, life-threatening medical condition or injury requires you to travel to a facility with the treatment you need, one-way ground, water and air transportation services by a licensed commercial carrier are covered.

Transportation outside of Alaska is limited to Seattle, Washington.

Medical transportation

If you require care for a medical condition that is not available at a local facility, round-trip transportation services by a licensed commercial carrier are covered for you and a registered nurse or doctor³ to the nearest facility that can provide you with the care you need. A parent or legal guardian may travel with members under the age of 18.

A prior authorization is required.

This benefit also covers travel for:

- First visit and one follow-up visit for therapeutic treatment
- One visit for pre-or postnatal care and one visit for the actual delivery
- One pre- or post-surgery visit and one visit for the actual surgery
- One visit for each allergic condition
- 1 Out-of-network Tier 3 ground ambulance providers may bill members for charges over the maximum plan allowance.
- 2 Services provided by a stretcher car, wheelchair car or other similar methods are not covered. These services are considered custodial.
- 3 Prior authorization is required. Written certification from the attending physician must be submitted and travel must be approved in advance. Reimbursement is limited to the cost of commercial air fare based on the lowest fare available at the time of the reservation. Expenses or fees beyond the cost of the airline ticket are not covered.
