Decolonizing Alaska Exhibit

A grant has been submitted to the Petersburg Community Foundation to bring *Decolonizing Alaska* to Petersburg. This is *a* travelling multimedia visual art exhibit that features 31 pieces by contemporary native and non-native Alaskan artists to Petersburg. Works are in wide array of mediums from traditional (paintings, carvings) to unconventional (fish skin, moose antler). If successful, we would host the show for approximately 6 weeks early in 2019. Due to the size and scope of the exhibit, we anticipate that we will need to have pieces on display not only at the library, but also at the museum and Borough offices. As part of the exhibit fee a professional curator will come to Petersburg to install the display. A curator talk and possible artist workshop is also included in the fee.

Veronica Bilenkin, a graduate student pursuing a Master's Degree in Library and Information Studies has been hired for the position. She comes to us from South Salem, New York. We'll be looking for a bike for her as well as volunteers who might like to take her out for some fine Petersburg experiences (boating, hiking).
